The Congress will be held in South Korea, from August 11-18, 2002. The program will include plenary sessions, contributed presentations (symposia and posters), round table discussions and thematic workshops. A major component will be field excursions conducted before, during and after the Congress, as well as cultural and social events.

### Scientific Program

The theme of the Congress is "Ecology in a Changing World." Within this general area, the Congress will examine the degradation of ecosystems and focus on their restoration and renewal. The emphasis will be on how ecological science can address environmental issues, and symposia will discuss new findings, new theories and paradigms, new methodological approaches and information technologies.
